RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The Fashion House Assistant will constantly interface with Mary, acting as her liaison between all departments. - Mary is warm but stern. She is regarded by her employees as a visionary and expects both creative vision and hard work from her staff – especially her "right hand" Fashion House Assistant.
